
With this being our 90th anniversary year all delegates are also invited to an evening of entertainment on the Friday night where you'll be able to catch-up with friends, network, and dance the night away!

Yesterday (4th July) we launched a new British Sign Language (BSL) and Sign Supported English CPD that has been specifically written for aquatic teaching professionals.

Kaylë Brightwell, STA's Head of Qualification Development, says; "In the context of swimming, it's vital that we provide inclusive communicative-led opportunities for hearing impaired learners who can quite often struggle to understand a teacher's instruction in a busy lesson environment – and we want to give everyone the chance, no matter their age or ability, to learn how to swim in a fun, safe environment, and gain a key life skill."
