- By the end of April, we are on schedule to have more than 100 newly qualified Level 2 Award swimming teachers.
- Then, moving into the second quarter of the year, from May, we also could have another 325+ qualified swimming teachers joining the industry with many more courses being organised.

Price Freeze Despite Rising Inflation

Earlier this month, we confirmed that despite rising inflation there will be no price increases on membership and course fees in 2022, and for the tenth year in a row, prices will remain frozen on all certificate and badge awards.

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Boost for School Swimming in Arun

In 2018, we were selected by Inspire Leisure to manage their donation of £150,000 to promote swimming across the district of Arun. We've now come to the end of this first-of-its-kind programme, and we are delighted to report that more than 1000 primary aged school children in the region

have benefitted from free swimming lessons. The funding has also been used to train 27 new swimming teachers and to give 21 teachers pool safety training, which has helped boost the longer-term delivery of school and public lessons at local leisure facilities in Littlehampton, Arundel and Bognor.

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Trio of EQAs Appointed

Safety Training Awards confirmed this week the appointment of not one, but three new highly experienced EQAs – Anne-Marie Harriman, Maria Timperley and Rachel Done. Anne-Marie joins as a full-time EQA for STA, with Maria and Rachel appointed to support the rapid growth of ATCs. Russell Sparkes who left the EQA role this month so he can focus on his swim school full-time, has also agreed to continue to work on a casual basis to support the team.

New and Updated Qualifications from the Pool Plant Team


