## Safety Training Awards Releases New Advice on Becoming an Approved Training Centre

STA's awarding organisation, Safety Training Awards, recently announced that any business, organisation or tutor wanting to deliver STA regulated qualifications must become an Approved Training Centre (ATC). There is no cost to gain ATC status and it will be implemented in phases over the coming months – the deadline for completed applications to be submitted is 1st August 2018. ATC agreements can be submitted now without some or all of the required policy documents; this is on the understanding that those applicants agree to develop them for the approval process by the mandatory deadline date.

#### **Helping Disability Swimmers in Peterborough**

In line with our charity objective, "the preservation of human life by the teaching of swimming, lifesaving and survival techniques", STA is committed to helping local charities, clubs and groups. The latest project is with Peterborough Special Olympic Swimming Group (PSOSG), a voluntary charity group who have set up a 'Keep us Afloat, Going for Gold' campaign - this follows a restructure which has forced them to find a new venue for their 25 swimmers, who all have a disability and travel from three adjacent counties. PSOSG's amazing work has not gone unnoticed, with the group set to receive a Civic Sports Award. Along with a donation to help keep the club open, STA has donated swimming teaching resources, and provided swim caps and noodles for all the children.
